

Call for proposal for secondary school students

Become a Sustainability Ambassador!

The aim of the competition

For the first time this year, the Miskolc Campus Forum Green and Smart, a traditional international business conference organised by the students of the University of Miskolc in the North-Eastern Region of Hungary, will take place. On this occasion, the Universitas Miskolcinensis Foundation and the University of Miskolc are launching a competition for secondary school students.

This year, representatives of the economic and social life, politics and science will discuss current issues of sustainability with students in a special atmosphere. The forum will provide a platform for networking and dialogue between different actors to promote innovation. One of the main objectives of the conference is to foster the relationship between students and stakeholders.

Title of the application

Imagine a sustainable secondary school! Where would you like to study? Why would you stay here to study in this region?

Who can apply

Applications are open to all students studying in any secondary school in the North-Eastern Region of Hungary. We welcome applications from teams of 3-5 people.

Deadline, language, scope, and criteria for submission of applications The deadline for submission of applications is Friday 5 May 2023.

The application must be accompanied by a completed and signed entry form with a consent form. Applications may be submitted in Hungarian or English. The written application, containing the ideas, proposals and suggestions of the applicant team and



a detailed description of these, must be a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 10 pages and meet the following minimum requirements.

Minimum content requirements for project proposals

- the proposals in the project plan are in line with the objectives of the application,
- the project design takes into account the following sustainability objectives:

The social impact of the institution:

- o preparing students for the labour market,
- equal opportunities,
- o promoting a good quality of life,
- the social impact of education,
- o the use of knowledge in cooperation.

The environmental impact of the institution:

- education and research focused on environmental awareness and sustainability, academic recognition,
- o sustainable institutional functioning, commitment to it,
- research in areas related to the UN Sustainable Development Goals.

The economic impact of the institution:

- the image of the institution in terms of economic sustainability taking into account the sustainability aspects,
- o measures taken for sustainable management,
- sustainability of resources.
- the programme plan developed in the project plan and its feasibility are realistic and consistent,
- the ideas in the project plan take into account the traditions of the institution,
- the proposals made will contribute to the development of the the development of the City of Miskolc and the North-Eastern Region of Hungary.

We provide student mentoring to help you prepare your application.

Minimum formal requirements for entries



 entries should be written in Times New Roman font, 12 point font size and 1.5 point margins,

 You may also submit annexes of up to 10 pages, but annexes do not count towards the total length of the application.

The team must produce a 3-minute video in which they present their entry in addition to the introduction.

How to apply

Applications can be submitted in person or by post and on paper to the Secretariat of the Board of Trustees of the Foundation, Prof. Dr. Nora Jakab (Building A 4, 1st Floor, Room 133) and electronically by sending an e-mail to titkarsag@umalapitvany.hu. No substitutions are possible.

Evaluation of applications

Applications will be evaluated in a one-round procedure, following an evaluation by a 5-member jury of experts. The first three entries will be awarded a prize. Gold, Silver and Bronze Diplomas will be awarded to the submissions of the teams. The team with the Gold Diploma will be awarded the title "Ambassador of Sustainability" for a period of one year. The jury will score the entries according to the given evaluation criteria and criteria. If there are no entries that reach a diploma level, the prize assigned to the diploma level will not be awarded. If more than one entry meets the criteria for a diploma level, the entries will be ranked according to their scores and awarded the additional, lower diploma level.

Results of the competition and awards

Gold Diploma: voucher in the value of HUF 300,000 Silver Diploma: voucher in the value of HUF 200,000 Bronze Diploma: voucher in the value of HUF 100,000

The evaluation criteria and criteria are as follows:



Evaluation criteria

- 1. To what extent does the entry address the following areas:
 - a. development ideas in the field of education, research (score: max. 5 points)
 - b. international aspects (score: max. 5 points)
 - c. social responsibility, social and corporate relations of the the institute (score: max 5 points)
 - d. secondary school services (score: max. 5 points)
 - e. student, housing, sport (score: max. 5 points)
 - f. communications (score: max. 5 points)
- 2. Is the sustainability project plan feasible? (score: max. 5 points)
- 3. How much innovation (novelty) is present in the entry (score: max. 10 points)
- Does the proposal set out a vision for sustainability for the institution? (score: max.
 points)
- 5. To what extent do the ideas in the application take into account the current facilities and equipment of the institution? (score: max. 10 points)
- 6. The feasibility of the proposals set out in the application, the elaboration of each work process. (score: max. 10 points)
- 7. The contribution of the entry to the economic, social and environmental sustainability of the institution, the results of the entry (does the entry contain new results, novelties, proposals). (score: max. 15 points)
- 8. Structure and style of the essay (coherence of the chapters, logical connection, language, accuracy, scientific, exacting, typing/spelling/linguistic errors). (score: max. 10 points)

According to the points awarded on the basis of the criteria:

90 - 100 points: Gold Diploma

89 - 80 points: Silver Diploma

79 - 70 points: Bronze Diploma



Notification of the outcome of the competition

The results will be announced at the Miskolc Campus Forum Green and Smart international business conference on 18 May 2023. Following the announcement of the results, local press coverage will be given to the winners.
